2013 GMAC/M-DCPS Game Limitations

- 22 Contests allowed – Regular season contest (not inclusive of permissible preseason and post season contest).
- No limitations on number of games per week, restriction is on per season (22).
- 1 early class release per week, all other releases must make use of private after school transportation. Note: due to facilities some exceptions may be granted.
- Exceptions must be approved by the GMAC.
- Number of games played cannot exceed the GMAC game limitations.
- GMAC Championship does not count in total game count.
- GMAC Tournament will be an 8 team format.

Scheduling Format

- District scheduling will be done by the athletic directors. All changes to the District schedule must be approved by your athletic director.
- All other matches and tournaments will be scheduled at a scheduling meeting and approved by your school’s athletic director.

Regulations

- Students in their fourth (4th) year of eligibility or in the twelfth (12th) grade, which ever comes first, may not participate on any junior varsity team.
- A student cannot participate as a member of varsity and sub-varsity teams on the same day. FHSAA Policy 6, 6.1.3

2013 GMAC Junior Varsity Baseball Scheduling Regulations

- Saturday or evening contest only in Miami-Dade County. Out of county games may be played on any day. Double headers with a JV/Varsity format are permissible.
- All scheduled Saturday games must be doubleheaders.
- Open scheduling will be the format used to schedule all JV games.
- Officials must be assigned by the GMAC.
