

Dear Football Officials:

This is to make you aware that the 2012-13 Football Officials Rules Exam becomes available online on Monday, August 13 through Wednesday, August 22, 2012.

You may begin the exam by logging in to your official account at: <https://officials.fhsaa.org>. To begin the exam, you will click on the "Testing" link on the left side menu.

****IMPORTANT CHANGES FOR THE 2012-13 SCHOOL YEAR****

THE FHSAA IS NO LONGER REQUIRING A MANDATORY RULES VIDEO PRESENTATION WITH THE SHORT QUIZ AT THE END. You may, however, access the presentation online by going to: <http://www.fhsaa.org/sports/football/faq>. There, you will see a link for the 2012 FHSAA and NFHS Rules Changes and Points of Emphasis.

****Please also note that in the 2012-13, there are no longer 'closed' and 'open' book exams. All exams are the same – 50 questions and timed for 75 minutes. It does not matter if you selected either open or closed book exams during your registration. There will also be an online make-up exam available after the initial testing completed. The make-up exam schedule is September 6-12.**

The FHSAA Officials Exam consists of 50 questions. You must select the BEST answer for each question. You will have 75 minutes for ALL exams to complete and review these questions.

During this exam, if you navigate away, or shut down your computer, the clock will still be running, and will complete your exam after the set time limit.

You may answer each question or <SKIP> a question and go back to it later. After you complete your exam and click <SUBMIT QUESTION> you will have an opportunity to see those questions you skipped and answer them at that time. You will also have the opportunity to review and change your submitted answers. Once you click <COMPLETE TEST>, your exam is tentatively scored, which may be adjusted if a question is either thrown out or the system has the wrong answer encoded. PLEASE DO NOT CLICK ON THE <COMPLETE TEST> BUTTON UNTIL YOU ARE COMPLETELY FINISHED WITH THE EXAM.

After you click on <BEGIN EXAM> below, your exam will be generated for you. The timer will start once the exam is generated. As you proceed through the exam, you will be reminded how much time is remaining. Good Luck!
